

I. Departments with farm cases since July 2022

9 departments currently have at least one restriction area due to an outbreak in poultry farms: Loire-Atlantique, Deux-Sèvres, Vendée, Gers, Vaucluse, Côtes-d'Armor, Tarn-et-Garonne, Eure, Eure-et-Loir.

Concerning the department of Gers (32), Loire-Atlantique (44), Deux-Sèvres (79), Vaucluse (84) and Vendée (85), the DGAL is in the process of finalising the study of surveillance data in order to lift the restricted zones in the near future, which will allow these departments to recover their free status in the absence of a new outbreak.

No outbreaks have been confirmed in poultry farms during the previous 7 days.

Sanitary measures, zoning

As for all outbreaks, as soon as the suspicion was raised, sanitary management measures were triggered within the EU regulatory implemented zoning (3 km Protection Zone "ZP" and 10 km Surveillance Zone "ZS" around the farm): culling of poultry on affected farms (either as a preventive measure or at the latest the day after NRL confirmation), reinforcement of biosecurity measures, census of farms and ban on poultry movements.

Raising the risk level

The level of risk with regard to HPAI has been raised from "moderate" to "high" (*ministerial decree of 8 November 2022*), which makes the compulsory confinement of poultry by their keepers since 11 November 2022 throughout metropolitan France.

II. Free status recovery

Since the last note, the department of Maine-et-Loire (49) has regained its free status.
